INFORMATION TO ENTER THE UK

The United Kingdom is taking the following steps to help stop the spread of COVID-19:

1) All persons (including UK nationals and residents) arriving in the UK must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken within 3 days of departure to the UK. For further information please visit: www.gov.uk/guidance/coronavirus-covid-19-testing-for-people-travelling-to-england

2) Everyone must complete an online passenger locator form before arrival in the United Kingdom. For further information please visit: www.gov.uk/passenger-locator-form

3) All arrivals must self-isolate for 10 days unless exempt.

4) It is a legal requirement that you wear a face covering on public transport in the UK.

5) If you self-isolate in England, you may opt into Test to Release Program. For further information please visit: www.gov.uk/guidance/coronavirus-covid-19-test-to-release-for-international-travel

Failure to comply with the above measures is a criminal offence, you could be offloaded from your flight and you could be arrested and/or fined.
